Visitor Accessibility Statement

Location

Our beautiful, Georgian building is located in Rutland Square, a stone's throw away from Edinburgh's vibrant Princes Street. The Clubhouse is easily accessible via public transport as it is situated 0.4 miles from Haymarket Station, 0.9 miles from Waverley Station and 7.2 miles from Edinburgh Airport. The closest tram and bus stops are less than 0.1 miles from the Clubhouse (West End tram stop and Shandwick Place bus stop).

Parking

The Clubhouse does not have any dedicated parking but on-street parking is available at Rutland Square (38 spaces) and it is not usually too busy. Parking meters are available for cash payments or payment can be made via app. Parking costs £3.40 per hour (max 4 hours). In the unlikely event that parking in the square is unavailable, we would recommend Semple Street Car Park as it is reasonably priced and only a short walk from the Clubhouse.

Entry

Entry to the Clubhouse is through the main entrance at the front of the building and can be accessed via five stone steps. Visitors should ring the bell at the front door for access. A ramp is available to guests with access requirements. Please ring the office on 0131 229 8157 and a member of staff can assist.

Stairs

The Clubhouse has three accessible levels. The Dining Room and toilets are located on the ground floor, the Club Room and bar on the 1st floor and the Studio, Reading Room and single toilet on 2nd floor. Our grand staircase is fitted with a stair lift to ensure that everyone can enjoy the Club. Please ask staff for assistance.

Toilets

Male, female and disabled toilets are available on the ground floor, this is shared with a baby change area. An additional toilet is available from the Reading Room on the top floor.
